Notice of Proposed Amendment 2023-017 – DASR ‘Air Navigation Service Providers’

This Newsbreak is to advise that DASA has published DASR Notice of Proposed Amendment (NPA) 2023-017 for DASR *Air Navigation Service Providers* for external consultation.

DASA welcomes responses from the wider Defence aviation community by close of business Tuesday 2 Apr 24, to allow the proposal’s incorporation into the Jul 24 DASR release.

NPA 2023-017 proposes the introduction of a revised DASR ANSP Part, Acceptable Means of Compliance (AMC) and Guidance Material (GM), to:

- address a DASA-identified shortfall in Defence ANSP regulation
- align DASR with best practice Civil Aviation Authority (CAA) and Military Aviation Authority (MAA) navigation approvals’ regulations
- enhance aviation safety in Defence Air Navigation Service provision.
