INAPPROPRIATE USE OF DASR 147 MTO APPROVAL

DASA has recently become aware of an organisation claiming they held a Defence Aviation Safety Regulation (DASR) 147 Maintenance Training Organisation (MTO) approval when they did not.

This Newsbreak serves as a reminder that DASA can only accept training outcomes from an MTO approved in accordance with DASR 147, or from an MTO approved by a recognised airworthiness authority, within the scope of their approval.
