



## RELEASE OF AMENDED DASP MANUAL VOLUME 3 CHAPTERS DASA OVERSIGHT & CONTINUING AIRWORTHINESS

DASA has amended the following DASP Manual (DASPMAN) Volume 3 Chapters related to DASA Oversight and Continuing Airworthiness:

- 4.1.4 – *Oversight and Enforcement* – significant chapter revision
- 5.4 – *Oversight and Enforcement* – significant chapter revision including management of DASA findings
- 8.3.3 – *Certification of Maintenance* – updated to include content from Aviation Maintenance Supervision & Certification seminars delivered by DASA in 2024
- 8.3.4 – *Acceptance of Aircraft Components* – minor update to remove ambiguous content associated with an Authorised Release Certificate
- 8.3.5 – *Flexibility Provisions for Maintenance Organisations* – minor update to remove ambiguous content associated with invalidation of organisational approvals
- 8.4.3. – *MAML Applications* – clarifies expectations when submitting a MAML application with aging (>10yrs) qualifications.
