



01/2025 Aviation Safety Officer Advanced Course - 29 Apr - 02 May 25, Canberra

The Defence Flight Safety Bureau (DFSB) will be hosting the 01/25 Aviation Safety Officer (ASO) Advanced Course, which is being held at the Mercure Canberra during the period 29 Apr - 02 May 25 inclusive. DFSB are extending the nomination window to 22 Apr in order to fill the remaining places.

The course aim is to graduate senior Aviation Safety Officers including Base, Wing, Regiment, Fleet, Group and Command ASOs. The course provides theory and practical exercises in the broad topics of the Defence Aviation Safety Management System, human factors, and base/unit emergency response. The course has been expanded to improve applied risk management skills and understanding of complex command led investigations.

Prerequisites for the course are the completion of ASO Initial course and experience as an ASO (or equivalent).

Nominations for this course are through your respective Command ASOs.
