Notice of Proposed Amendment for DASR Change Proposal 2024-003 DASR Uncrewed Aircraft Systems

DASA wishes to advise that DASR Notice of Proposed Amendment (NPA) 2024-003 is now published for DASR *Uncrewed Aircraft Systems* (UAS).

DASA welcomes responses from the Defence UAS community by close of business **Monday 05 Dec 25**, to allow the proposal's incorporation into the Jul 26 DASR release.

NPA 2024-003 proposes the amendment of the DASR UAS Part, Acceptable Means of Compliance (AMC) and Guidance Material (GM), to:

- improve UAS Operating Permit (UASOPS) application requirements and guidance
- provide organisation requirements for an updated two-tier suite of standard scenarios
- introduce an Authorised UAS Organisation framework for standard scenarios with expanded permissions
- improve Aviation Safety and flexibility for UAS operations under the Specific Type B and Open categories
- align DASR UAS with best practice Civil Aviation Authority (CAA) and Military Aviation Authority (MAA) UAS regulation where practicable.
