Notification of Proposed Amendment for DCP 0068: Incorporation of EMAR 21 Edition 3.0 Amendments into DASR 21

DASA wishes to advise NPA to DCP 0068: Incorporation of EMAR 21 Edition 3.0 Amendments into DASR 21 has been published for consultation.

DASA welcomes responses from the Defence Aviation Safety Community, by **close of business Friday 28 August 2026**.

To align DASR 21 with EMAR 21, DASA proposes adopting EMAR 21 Edition 3.0 regulations, AMC, and GM into DASR 21. Key changes focus on clarifying the Design Approval Holder's responsibilities for developing and maintaining Instructions for Continuing Airworthiness (ICA). The proposal also includes several minor updates throughout DASR 21.

DASA intends to hold a virtual Town Hall style briefing during the period the NPA is open for comments. Further details will be advised.
