



AMENDMENT TO DASR FORM 19/19A - APPLICATION FOR DASR 66 MAML

DASA wishes to advise that revised versions of Form 19 & 19A – Application for DASR 66 Military Aircraft Maintenance Licence (MAML) – are now available on the [DASR Forms and Templates](#) internet site.

Major changes to Form 19 (functionally replicated in Form 19A) include:

Section 1 – Applicant Information

- Applicant information restructured and simplified

Section 2 – Work Details

- Prefilled drop down box for DASA 145 organisation details

Section 4 – Application Scope

- Clear separation of application type (initial, category, type rating)
- Exclusion/Inclusion text box added
- OJT evidence required for first type rating

Section 7 – Type Ratings

- Streamlined section with removal of retired aircraft
- Prompt for Type Rating OJT evidence (for first type rating)

Section 8 – Aeroskills Competency Units

- Updated to MEA Aeroskills Release 6.0 (Sep 2025)

Section 9 – Experience & Evidence

- Consolidated experience requirements aligned to DASR 66.A.30

Section 10 – Declarations

- Employee and QM declarations now mandatory
