



Release of out-of-cycle DASR Amendment

An amendment to the [Defence Aviation Safety Regulation](#) (DASR) was released on 20 Aug 26. This amendment incorporated one major, three minor, and one editorial change. The primary purpose of this out-of-cycle release is to provide improved regulatory supporting information for aviation safety occurrence reporting.
