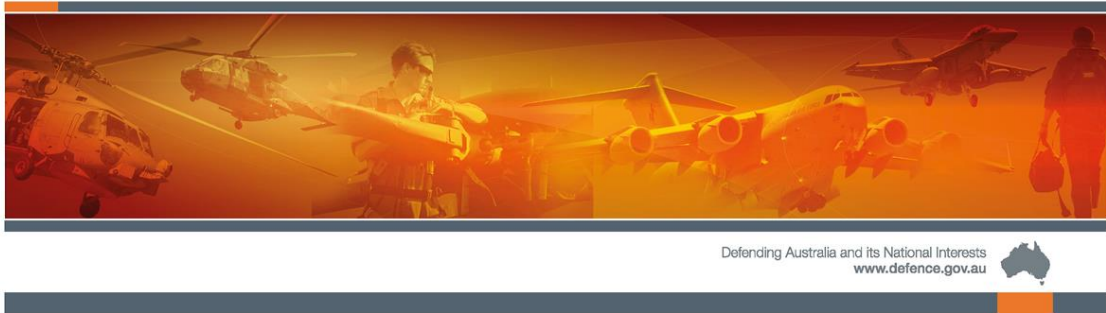

COMPOSITE SPECIALIST COURSE

Course duration

6 Weeks

Course Content

The course provides course participants with the knowledge, skills and attitudes required to assess and repair damage to ADF composite aircraft structures and covers the critical technical issues associated with the maintenance and repair of composite aircraft structures.

Prerequisites

- **Course Prerequisite Competency Units**
 - National Aerospace Competency MEA405B - Repair/Modify Aircraft Composite Material Structure/Component
 - National Aerospace Competency MEA339 - Inspect, Repair and Maintain Aircraft Structures

For Air Force, Army and contractor personnel, MEA405B is the minimum requirement to attend the Composite Specialist Course. This unit of competency can be attained by successfully completing the ASTFITT Composite Repair and Fabrication Techniques course (112472) or the ADF Aircraft Composites course (213986). For Navy personnel, the ADF Aircraft Composites course (213986) is the minimum requirement.

Target Audience

To train Air Force, Army and civilian contractor Aircraft Structural Technicians and Navy Aircraft Technicians to perform composite repair techniques on all ADF fixed and rotary wing aircraft.

Training Nominations

Defence Personnel: All ACT courses are registered on PMKeyS. When nominating for a course, the member's Unit Training Coordinator (UTC) or delegate is to nominate on PMKeyS. Due to limited course numbers it is recommended detailed amplifying comments and priority upgrade accompany all course nominations.

Contractor nominations: It is Defence policy to charge Non-Government and Government organisations when Defence supplies goods or services in accordance with Australian Government Cost Recovery Guidelines (Resource Management Guide No. 302, 304) and Defence Finance Group guidance. The cost of the Composite Specialist Course is \$7305, as such, Civilian contractor nominations are to be forwarded and authorised through their relevant sponsoring System Project Office (SPO). Headquarters Air Force Training Group will only accept nominations from the SPO's nominated liaison officer. Authorisation from the sponsoring SPO regards Course Cost Recovery must be given prior to nomination.
