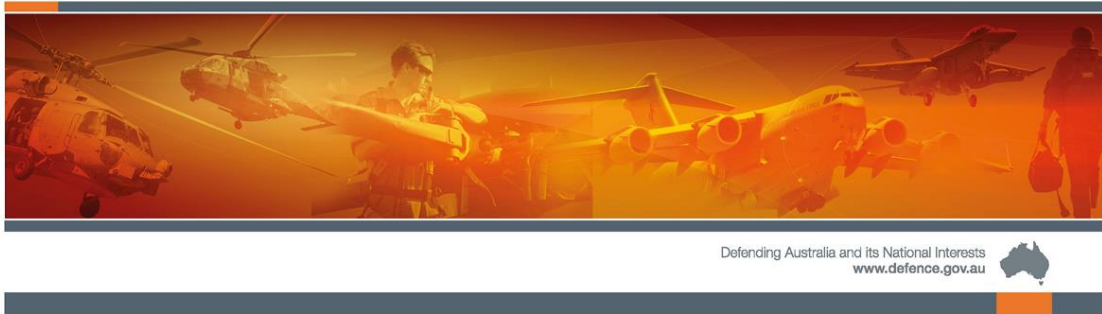

## **DASR 21 INTRODUCTION TO INITIAL AIRWORTHINESS**

### **Course Code**

215182

### **Course Duration**

The course is designed for self-paced remote learning, using the ADELE Learning Management System. It is expected that most students will complete the course in approximately 4-6 hrs. The course is open online to be completed over a period of 2 weeks.

### **Course Content**

This course provides an introduction to the structure of DASR 21, initial airworthiness authorisations and the elements of continued airworthiness. It also provides detailed explanation of the organisational requirements for the applicant or holder of a Military Type Certificate, design organisation approval and production organisation approval.

### **Target Audience**

Anyone requiring a base-level understanding of initial airworthiness in the Defence Aviation Safety Framework. This includes people working in design organisations, organisations holding Military Type Certificates, Military Air Operators, or any of their service providers.
