## ACCOUNTABLE MANAGER SUPPORTING STAFF COURSE (AMSSC)

### Course Code

217271

### Duration

1 day

### Content

DASA delivers the AMSSC to 'Flight Operations / Operational Airworthiness' Military Air Operator staff (FEG/COMD/ARM and subordinate units) who support a Military Air Operator – Accountable Manager to meet their accountabilities/responsibilities under the Defence Aviation Safety Framework (DASF). DASA may also deliver the AMSSC to Accountable Managers if they wish to have further detail than is provided in the Military Air Operator – Accountable Manager Course (216054).

Key learning outcomes are:

- understand the DASF
- understand the roles and responsibilities of those Flight Operation appointments responsible for the promotion and enhancement of Defence Aviation Safety
- support the duties of an Accountable Manager with respect to:
  - WHS Act legal liabilities
  - DASR Obligations
  - award and maintenance of operational Organisation Approvals and Authorisations.
  - application of Risk Management in support of DASR Flexibility Provisions
  - application of Quality Management in the context of Defence Aviation.

## **Target Audience**

Members posted to Military Air Operator Accountable Manager supporting staff positions (including SQN/WG/Regt Flight Operation Executives) involved in management of Flight Operations and DASR compliance. Continuing Airworthiness Organisation and Military Type Certificate Holder Executive staff are also encouraged to attend. Accountable Managers may also wish to attend.
