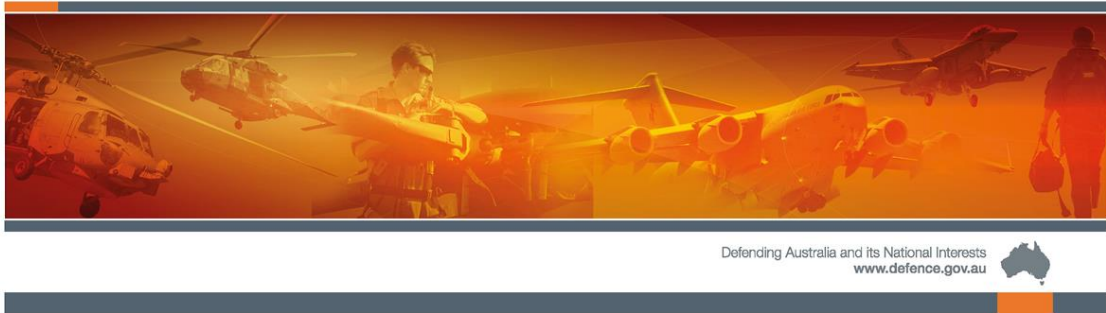

### DO-326A Airworthiness Cyber Security Training

#### **Course Code**

219045

#### **Course duration**

4 half days – Either 0800h – 1200h

#### **Course Content**

Utilizing the DO-326A standard set inclusive of DO-355A and DO-356A, as a basis for the course (being the ADF preferred cyber security assurance standard), this course provides an overview of the cyber security assurance ecosystem and the Authority's involvement in Major Cyber security projects.

#### **Target Audience**

The course is aimed at software and cyber security practitioners involved in airborne cyber security engineering and cyber security assurance. However, engineers conducting Design Approval and inspections of Compliance Demonstration evidence of safety related aviation cyber security will also find this course useful.

Maximum of 25 participants

## Cost
