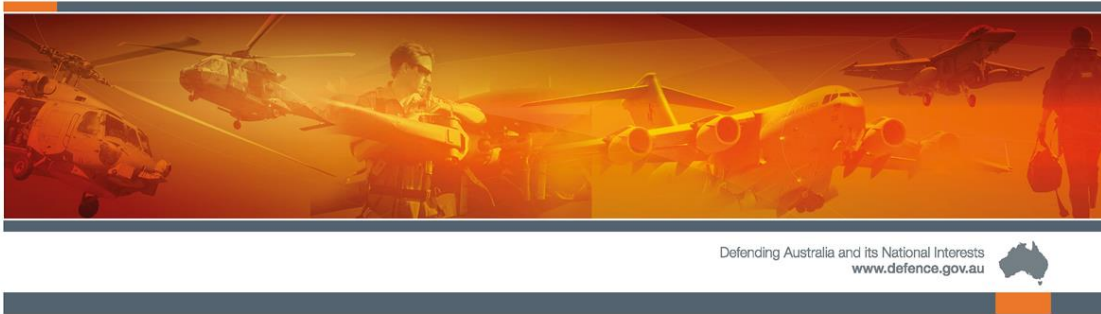

This course provides detailed knowledge of continuing airworthiness concepts, and an overview of the DASR M regulations and their implementation.

The course is primarily self-paced learning through ADELE, with a 1 hour live discussion with DASA staff.
