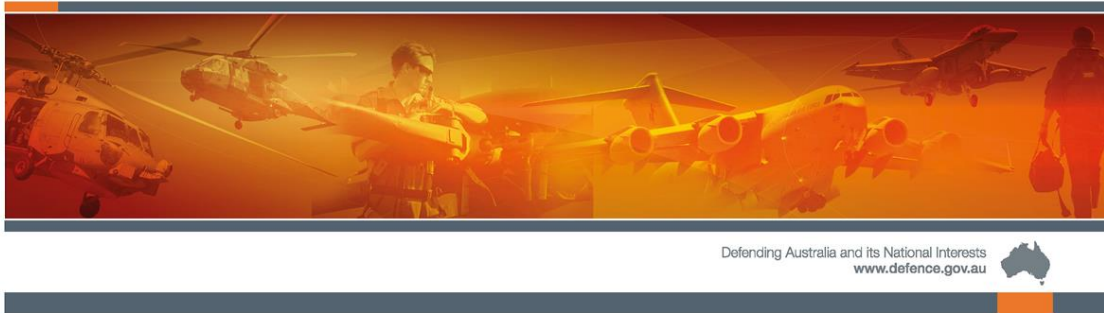

Course Content

The Military Type Certificate Holder (MTCH) Obligations Course is designed to provide training to personnel who are responsible for and are involved in the execution of MTCH functions. Personnel who attend this course will be provided with the knowledge and skills required to understand the MTCH role in ensuring the continued airworthiness of ADF platforms.

Course Pre-Requisites

This course requires the completion of Defence Aviation Safety Regulation Part 21 Introduction to Initial Airworthiness (215182) before enrolment. Additionally, it is recommended that you complete the Type Certification Course (216207).

Target Audience

Members of Defence or contractors to Defence supporting or working in MTCH organisations.
