DASA wishes to advise that Notices of Proposed DASR Amendments (NPA) 2020-016 DASR part 145 proposed amendments and deletions and (NPA) 2020-023 DASR Part M proposed amendments and deletions have been published for external consultation and welcomes responses from the wider Defence aviation community prior to 01 Mar 21.

These NPAs propose changes to AMC and GM in DASR M, and 145 as identified by DASR green text review with the intent to amend and/or delete Acceptable Means of Compliance (AMC) and Guidance Material (GM) green text that does not provide any additional clarity or guidance to the associated regulation.
