### DEFENCE AVIATION SAFETY MANUAL DRAFT AL2 NOTICE OF REVIEW

DASA wishes to advise that the draft AL2 to Defence Aviation Safety Manual (DASM) is now available for review on the [DFSB Intranet website](#). Accountable Managers (FEG commanders or equivalent) have been requested to evaluate and compile feedback from organisations in their chain of command on behalf of DFSB. Defence aviation community members are invited to contribute to this feedback process. Responses are requested by 11 Jul 20.

AL2 to the DASM is scheduled for release on 14 Aug 20 which allows for a review period of six weeks prior to publish date. AL2 realigns the legacy 12 ASMS elements to the four components of DASR Safety Management System Regulation (DASR.SMS). As part of this alignment, the DASM chapters are being structured into a Policy-Procedure-Guidance format. The development of the DASM is underpinned by a Project Management Plan (DPMP) and takes a phased approach to ensure changes to this manual considers all stakeholders.
