2022 Senior Aviation Safety Officer Conference

DASA wishes to advise that

The 2022 Senior Aviation Safety Officer (SASO) Conference will now be held on **Monday, 21 November 2022** (vice the originally advertised 18 Nov 22 date). The SASO Conference will be held at Adams Hall, Australian Defence Force Academy.

This change in date has become necessary due to a competing priority beyond the control of DFSB.

The SASO Conference is an Aviation Safety Forum targeted at Senior ASOs, i.e. those serving at higher than unit commands, within the Defence Aviation Community (DAC), and serves as an important method of engagement between the DAC and DFSB.

The Conference will focus on contemporary and arising safety issues. Discussion topics include the following:

- DASM Dis-entanglement Project
- ASR and Fatigue reporting
- Updates on major investigations
- Individual Service Updates
- Additional Topics from the DAC
