Interim Military Maintenance Authority (iMMA) Applications

DASA issued AC 001/2021 detailing the interim arrangements for certification of on-aircraft structural repairs and the introduction of an interim 'Military Maintenance Authority' (iMMA) for Structural Technicians. In order to expedite the processing of applications DASA has introduced an evidence guide detailing the minimum evidence required to be submitted along with the application. Applications submitted with insufficient evidence will require the applicant to provide the additional evidence to justify the approval of the iMMA, which may cause delays in processing.
