Defence Aviation Safety Authority –DFSB-led Aviation Safety Training Alternate Delivery

DASA wishes to advise that DFSB will soon commence delivery of Aviation Safety Training (AST) courseware via alternate delivery methods, though delays to original course dates are expected.

DFSB delivers Aviation Incident Investigation Course (AIIC), Aviation Safety Officer Initial (ASO(I)), Aviation Safety Officer Advanced (ASO(A)) and Non-Technical Skills - Train-the-Trainer (NTS). Learning outcomes are best served through face-to-face means, but adaptation is now required.

DFSB will deliver distance-based, instructor-led, variations of the aforementioned courses via ADELE commencing with AIIC on 12th May. Delays to ASO(I) and ASO(A) are expected while courseware is refined for distance based delivery; further detail will be provided to panelling authorities in the coming week.

DFSB have assessed that the existing network of NTS Trainers (within command elements) will enable the continuation of NTS Foundation Course and NTS Continuation training within units and as such will delay NTS for the foreseeable future. Where specific unit shortfalls are identified, DFSB may deliver NTS Foundation Course and NTS Continuation training directly to that unit via ADELE.
