Temporary Delays to MAML Applications

DASA is currently in the process of replacing its software tool used to approve and manage DASR 66 Military Aircraft Maintenance Licences (MAMLs). MAML applications and responses to DASR 66 enquiries may be delayed whilst the DASA 66 team complete the relevant testing, validation and implementation of the replacement MAML Tool. DCA-DASA expects any delays to be resolved by January 2022.
