## **AMENDMENT TO AIRWORTHINESS DESIGN REQUIREMENTS MANUAL (ADRM)**

DASA wishes to advise that a revised version of the ADRM has been released.

Significant changes resulting from this amendment are as follows:

### **Section 2 - Integrated Design Requirements**

New Chapter 12 - Cyber Security - presents Authority prescribed design requirements for cyber security to assist 'early adopters' to undertake cyber assessments for Defence aircraft.

### **Section 3 - Aircraft System Design Requirements**

Amended Chapter 2 - Communications Systems - deletion of the 'capability' design requirement related to Tactical Data Information Links as a result of the cancellation of the associated Defence Instruction, without replacement.

Amended Chapter 3 - Navigation Systems - revised airworthiness design requirements for Advanced RNP and Baro-VNAV to clarify the application of NAA requirements.

Amended Chapter 8 - Electrical Systems - added airworthiness design requirements for non-rechargeable Li-ion batteries used in aircraft systems.

### **Section 5 – Aircraft Support Systems**

Amended Chapter 2 - Aeronautical Life Support Equipment - amended design requirements for: Hearing Protection; CBRN Protection; Eye and Face Protection; Thermal/Immersion Protection and Underwater Emergency Breathing Devices.

**NOTE:** The 'Internet' link to the ADRM (per below) has changed. The legacy link will remain active for 6 months from the date of publication of this update, after which time it will become invalid.
