



EXTENSION OF ADVISORY CIRCULAR 008/2021 – INTERIM ARRANGEMENTS FOR MAML DISCREPANCIES RESULTING FROM PMKEYS PROFICIENCY ERRORS AND SUSPENDED MAML LIST UPDATE

MEA Remediation Program

1. DASA wishes to advise that Advisory Circular 008/2021 *Interim Arrangements for MAML Discrepancies Resulting from PMKeyS Proficiency Errors* has had its validity period extended until 01 December 2023 due to delays and difficulties experienced when remediating incomplete units of competency.
2. This AC summarises the actions to be taken by DASR 145 Maintenance Organisations when MAML holders have discrepancies on their MAML resulting from PMKeyS proficiency errors. These actions include interim processes to follow when continuing to authorise MAML holders that have missing MEA Units of Competency, as well as remediation to remove any MAML discrepancies.

Suspended MAML List Update

5. All DASR 145 Maintenance Organisations are to ensure that no personnel with a suspended MAML are issued a certification authorisation IAW DASR 145.A.35.
