Release of Advisory Circular 001/2021 Implementing Interim Arrangements for Certification of On-Aircraft Structural Repairs

DASA wishes to advise that Advisory Circular 001/2021 Implementing Interim Arrangements for Certification of On-Aircraft Structural Repairs, has been released.

This AC is intended to provide interim arrangements to close a MAML coverage gap that currently exists for some DASR 145 MOs when certifying on-aircraft structural repairs. This gap became apparent during the development of NPA 01/2020 and AC 005/2020, which clarified that certification of maintenance occurs when issuing a CRS.
