Notice of Proposed Amendment 2021-048 – Amendments to DASR 21 Certification Regulations based on EMAR 21 Edition 2.0

DASA wishes to advise that Notice of Proposed Amendment (NPA) 2021-048 – *Amendments to DASR 21 Certification Regulations based on EMAR 21 Edition 2.0* has been published for external consultation and welcomes responses from the wider Defence aviation community prior to 30 Nov 21.

This NPA proposes changes to certification regulations, Acceptable Means of Compliance (AMC) and Guidance Material (GM) contained within DASR 21 Subparts B, D and E. The changes proposed commence alignment of DASR 21 with EMAR 21 Edition 2.0 and provide improved Australian unique AMC and GM to clarify the approach to certification in the Defence context.
