Release of Factsheets – Military Aerodrome Certification Review Item and Aerodrome Issue Paper

DASA wishes to advise that the Military Aerodrome Certification Review Item (MACRI) and Aerodrome Issue Paper (ADIP) Factsheets have been released.

These Factsheets are relevant to those involved in certification of Defence Aerodromes and provide guidance on how non-compliances are handled as part of the DASR 139 Aerodrome Certification process.

The MACRI factsheet provides information about what is a MACRI. It identifies and describes the types of MACRIs and when each of them can be used. An outline of the overall process for addressing non-compliances in aerodrome design is also provided.

The ADIP factsheet aims to describe what constitutes an Aerodrome Issue Paper (ADIP), and illustrates the process for raising and processing an ADIP, including the roles of the Applicant/Person evaluating the non-compliance, and the roles of the Authority and Command.
