



Notice of Proposed Amendment 2022-019 – DASR ‘Air Battle Management (ABM)’

This Newsbreak is to advise that DASA has published DASR Notice of Proposed Amendment (NPA) 2022-019 for DASR Air Battle Management (ABM) for external consultation.

DASA welcomes responses from the wider Defence aviation community by close of business Friday 8 Sep 23, to allow the proposal’s incorporation into the Feb 24 DASR release.

NPA 2022-019 proposes the introduction of a new DASR ABM Part, Acceptable Means of Compliance (AMC) and Guidance Material (GM) to:

- address a DASA-identified shortfall in Defence ABM regulation
- enhance aviation safety in ABM.
