On the date of the new tool release, a Newsbreak will be released to confirm that the new tool is operational and the DASA FAQ webpage will be updated. ADF MAML applicants, and ADF DASR 145 quality managers, should commence using to the new DASR Form 19a as of now.

The extant MAML application process for Defence Industry will remain unchanged (DASR Form 19).
