Introduction

1. Appendix I to DASR 66 – Basic Knowledge identifies that applicants for a DASR 66 Military Aircraft Maintenance Licence (MAML) must complete Module 10 on Aviation Legislation.
2. DASA currently accepts evidence of Module 10 completion IAW References A & B.
3. At Reference C, DASA identified planned changes to Module 10 training.

ADELE ADF Module 10 Training

4. Air Force Training Group (AFTG) has finalised a new, Australian Defence Education Learning Environment (ADELE) based, DASR 66 Module 10 course for use by both ADF and Defence Industry: ADF DASR 66 Module 10 - Aviation Legislation – ADELE course code: 216881.
5. Course duration is approximately 5 hours.

Nomination

6. The course is via ADELE (O:S) – Enrolment Key: **ADFdasr66module10** (Case Sensitive).
7. Personnel with a DPN account can self-enrol into the course via ADELE through the following link: <https://www.adele.edu.au/course/view.php?id=48100> (Opens in a new tab/window)
 - a. Note a search for course code: 216881 in ADELE may list obsolete Module 10 training. The AFTG course at the above link is the only Module 10 course approved by DASA to obtain Module 10 competency.
8. Defence Industry (DI) members without a DPN account will need to obtain ADELE access for Module 10 via a request to the group mailbox: airprjdata@baesystems.au. AFTG points of contact that can directly assist are:

9. The process for granting access for DI staff who do not have a DPN account is:
 - a. A list of DI staff who do not have DPN accounts is provided to the group mailbox list above (cc one of the AFTG contacts),
 - b. The AFTG will send an email to [ADELE Support](#) requesting creation of an ADELE account for the DI member, and
 - c. An ADELE account will be created for DI members to complete the training using the enrolment key.

Reporting

1. DASA uses PMKeyS data to generate MAMLs for ADF members. ADELE does not automatically update PMKEYS with PMKeyS Code: P125860 at the completion of the course.

ADF members, are to ensure their PMKEYS record is updated manually through their chain of command.

2. For DI members, DASA will accept a Course Completion Certificate as objective evidence of completion of the Mod 10 Course.

Additional Information

3. As of Monday 01 January 2024, successful completion of the new ADELE (O:S) Module 10 course will be the only evidence that DASA will accept for MAML applications (i.e. from 01 January 2024, DASA will no longer accept evidence of Module 10 completion IAW References A & B).
4. The new ADELE based DASR Module 10 will not be retrospective – MAML holders who have previously completed Module 10 requirements prior to 01 January 2024 will not be required to re-sit the new course.
