



AMENDMENT TO AIRWORTHINESS DESIGN REQUIREMENTS MANUAL (ADRM)

DASA wishes to advise that a revised version of the ADRM has been released.

This issue of the ADRM incorporates the following changes:

Various chapters.

Change 'manned' and 'unmanned' terminology to 'crewed' and 'uncrewed'.

References to CAO 20.18 replaced with CASR Part 91 and associated Manual of Standards.

Section 1

Chapter 3 Airworthiness Codes. Inclusion of CASR Parts 91 and 121 (and associated Manual of Standards) within the DASA recognised airworthiness code prescribed by the CASA.

Section 3

Chapter 12. Title change to 'Aircraft Structures'.

Chapter 13 Propulsion Systems. Minor administrative and clarification changes.

Section 5

Chapter 2 Aeronautical Life Support Equipment. Amended content associated with Night Vision Imaging Systems design requirements.

Chapter 7 Petroleum, Oils, Lubricants and Allied Products. Rewritten chapter to reflect management of POLAP within aircraft type certification under DASR.
