The Snapshot survey is administered annually to personnel from Air Force, Army Aviation, Fleet Air Arm, Air Domain (Capability Acquisition & Sustainment Group), and other selected elements. In recent years, the program has also been expanded to be administered to select Defence aviation contractors and the Royal New Zealand Air Force.
