



Extension of Advisory Circular 008/2021 – Interim arrangements for MAML discrepancies resulting from PMKeyS proficiency errors

DASA wishes to advise that Advisory Circular 008/2021 – Interim arrangements for MAML discrepancies resulting from PMKeyS proficiency errors – has had its validity period extended until 30 June 2023 due to difficulties experienced when remediating incomplete units of competencies.

This AC summarises the actions to be taken by DASR 145 Maintenance Organisations when MAML holders have discrepancies on their MAML resulting from PMKeyS proficiency errors. These actions include interim processes to follow when continuing to authorise MAML holders that have missing MEA Units of Competencies, as well as remediation to remove any MAML discrepancies.
