



## Release of the new DASR 66 MAML tool

This Newsbreak provides notice that the new DASR 66 MAML tool, which DASA uses to process new or amended MAML applications, is now operational.

The [DASA FAQ](#) webpage has been updated to direct ADF applicants and quality managers to the new [DASR Form 19a](#).

All applications, both ADF and Defence Industry, will be processed through the new tool.

ADF application emails generated through the old tool will no longer be accepted. All ADF applications require a [Form 19a](#).

The extant MAML application process for Defence Industry will remain unchanged.
