DASA wishes to advise that the Military CVE – Roles and Responsibilities course has been released with sessions now available in Q4 2022 and Q1 2023.

This course is designed to provide training to personnel who are responsible for Aircraft Design and Certification activities under a Military Type-Certificate Holder (MTCH) or Military Design Organisation Approval (MDOA). Personnel who attend this course will be provided with the knowledge and skills required to understand the CVE role within the DASR 21 framework.

The course is sponsored by DASA and will be delivered virtually by a Subject Matter Expert from Baines Simmons (UK).

The first of these course sessions is scheduled for 08-09 Nov 22, so please submit your nomination as soon as possible.
