



MEA REMEDIATION PROGRAMME – SUSPENDED MAMLS

Background

1. DASA has identified variations between competencies recorded on the ADF's Human Resources tool (PMKeyS) and the achievement of related national Vocational Education and Training Units of Competencies; bringing into question the accuracy of some issued Military Aircraft Maintenance Licences (MAMLS).
2. DASA Advisory Circular 008/2021: Interim Arrangements for MAML Discrepancies Resulting from PMKeyS Proficiency Errors, was released to provide information on the interim authorisation of personnel with MAML discrepancies, as well as remediation processes.
3. Headquarters Air Force Training Group, with support from DASA, created a master list of all affected ADF aviation technicians with MAML discrepancies; including both members of the permanent forces (SERCAT 7) and ex-ADF or Reserve personnel.

Communiqué

4. DASA endeavoured to contact all non-SERCAT 7 MAML holders directly. Some non-SERCAT 7 MAML holders were unable to be contacted and DASA has suspended their MAML until contact can be re-established. MAMLS which are now suspended, identified by MAML number only, can be found on the DASA website at the link below.

5. All DASR 145 Maintenance Organisations are to ensure that no personnel with a suspended MAML is issued a certification authorisation IAW DASR 145.A.35
