Notice of Proposed Amendment 2021/007—DASR.ORO.30 'Flight Authorisation and Flying Supervision' – Revised Release Date

This Newsbreak cancels and replaces the 31 Aug 21 Newsbreak – *Notice of Proposed Amendment 2021/007 – DASR.ORO.30 'Flight Authorisation and Flying Supervision'*.

This Newsbreak also advises that DASA will not release the subject DASR on 28 Oct 21, due to delays in receipt and analysis of the Regulated Community's responses to the subject NPA.

NPA 2021/007 proposed the incorporation of modified Implementing Regulation (IR), Acceptable Means of Compliance (AMC), and Guidance Material (GM) in DASR.ORO.30, to address:

- recommendations/outcomes from relevant aviation safety investigations
- simplifications and updates for improved DASR clarity

DASA received comprehensive NPA responses from the Defence aviation community. To ensure regulatory due process, DASA will incorporate the updated ORO.30 into the 28 Apr 22 DASR release. DASA will upload a Comment Response Document on the DASA internet page, communicated by a separate Newsbreak, in due course.
