



Release of DASR Amendment

DASA advises that an amendment to the [Defence Aviation Safety Regulation](#) (DASR) has been released. This amendment incorporates three major, one minor and four editorial changes. The major changes amend the following:

- DASR ORO.30 *Flight Authorisation*
- DASR MED.05 *Aviation Medicine Training*
- DASR 21 Subpart B *Military Type-Certificates and Military Restricted Type-Certificates*
- DASR 21 Subpart D *Changes to Military Type-Certificates and Military Restricted Type-Certificates*
- DASR 21 Subpart E *Military Supplemental Type-Certificates*.
