



MoU renews aviation safety co-operation

DASA wishes to advise that the long-standing relationship between the Defence Flight Safety Bureau (DFSFB) and the Australian Transport Safety Bureau (ATSB) – and the organisations’ shared commitment to enhancing aviation safety – was fortified with the signing of a new Memorandum of Understanding (MoU) on the 14 September 2022.

Director DFSB Group Captain Dennis Tan and ATSB Chief Commissioner Angus Mitchell signed the MoU renewing their continued co-operation.

“The Memorandum of Understanding between ATSB and DFSB is vitally important and recognises the need for the two bureaus to work together and provide mutual support in the provision of a national transport safety investigation capability,” says Group Captain Tan.

Mr Mitchell reiterates: “Strengthening our co-operation by sharing resources, knowledge and expertise improves safety for all aviators – no matter what they fly – and the travelling public.”
