



## Release of DASR amendment, Advisory Circular and Factsheets

DASA advises that an amendment to the [Defence Aviation Safety Regulation](#) (DASR) has been released. Three new guidance documents have been published to support this amendment:

- [AC 005/2020 – Certification of Maintenance – DASA 145 MO and CAMO Responsibilities](#). This AC supersedes AC 006/2018 – Certificates of Release to Service Responsibilities for Maintenance Organisations and CAMOs.
- [Factsheet – Technical Evaluation of Role Equipment](#). This factsheet supports the implementation of DASR ORO.75 Use of Aircraft Role Equipment. The factsheet explains the considerations for categorising role equipment and the process of conducting technical evaluations to assist decision making under DASR ORO.75.
- [Factsheet – Establishing Compliance with DASR](#). This factsheet describes the two approaches to establishing compliance with the DASR; namely, the implementation of Acceptable Means of Compliance (AMC) and Alternative Means of Compliance (AltMoC). Its release coincides with an amendment to the DASR Glossary that clarifies the purpose of AMC and introduces AltMoC as a defined term.

This amendment incorporates two major changes as well as several minor and editorial changes. The two major changes are:

- ***Certification of Maintenance***. Removes all ‘green text’ referencing ‘Maintenance Certification’ as an Australian unique term defined within DASR M, 145, 66 and the DASR Glossary.
- ***Defence UAS Registration***. Resolves the inconsistent call-out of UAS registration within DASR while ensuring the intent of the UAS regulations remain extant.
