### ***Defence Aviation Safety Manual Edition 3 – Minor Editorial Update***

Defence Flight Safety Bureau (DFSB) wishes to advise that an amendment to the current edition of the Defence Aviation Safety Manual (DASM) will be incorporated.

Noting the DASM is scheduled to be withdrawn in Q1 2025, the DASM will remain at Edition 3 as changes only make corrections to terminology, grammar, tables and hyperlinks which is to improve readability and clarity.

These changes are categorised as minor and editorial. There are nil changes to the DASM structure or intent and do not represent risk to the Defence Aviation Community.
