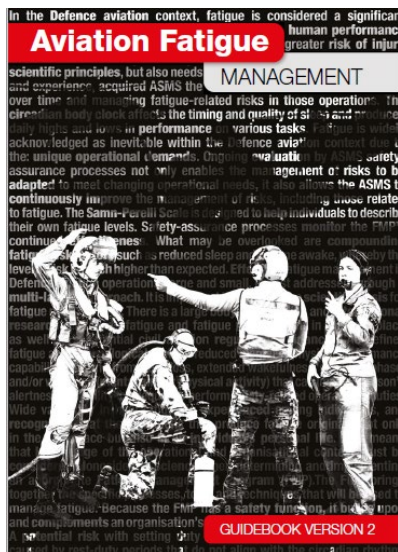




## Defence Aviation Fatigue Management Guidebook – Release of Version 2

### Overview

The *Aviation Fatigue Management Guidebook* provides guidance on meeting obligations in relation to fatigue management within the Defence aviation context. While parts of the guidebook focus on considerations specific to select Defence aviation occupations, the themes and concepts remain applicable to all operating contexts.
