



## ***Release of DASP Manual Vol 3 DASP Guidance and Withdrawal of Select DASA publications***

### **DASP Manual Volume 3 DASP Guidance**

DASA has released Defence Aviation Safety Program Manual Volume 3 [DASP Guidance](#). This Volume provides:

- an overview of the DASP and how its various elements collectively achieve the required safety objectives
- supporting information to promote understanding of concepts and processes spanning multiple requirements or provisions established through Volume 1 *Requirements for the DASP* and Volume 2 *Defence Aviation Safety Regulation*.

DASP Manual Volume 3 does not establish any requirements for the management of Aviation Safety. DASA Acceptable Means of Compliance and Guidance Material will continue to be published alongside relevant DASA clauses. The structure and content of DASP Manual Volume 3 will continue to mature throughout 2024 and 2025.

### **Withdrawal of select DASA publications**

Information previously contained within the Defence Aviation Safety Assurance Manual, as well as several Advisory Circulars and Factsheets, is now included within DASP Manual Volume 3.
