## ***Updated DASA Factsheet published – Synthetic Aviation Turbine Fuels***

DASA wishes to advise that the Synthetic Aviation Turbine Fuels Fact Sheet has been updated based on feedback provided from the community and the latest developments regarding synthetic aviation turbine fuel policy and guidance material. Change bars have been utilised to highlight amendments.

The factsheet provides guidance regarding the use of synthetic aviation turbine fuels within the Defence and Defence Aviation Safety Regulation (DASR) context. The aim of the factsheet is to provide guidance for the Military Air Operator (MAO) and the Military Type Certificate Holder (MTCH) organisation to ensure the use of synthetic aviation turbine fuels remains in-accordance-with the platform's Military Type Certificate (MTC). This factsheet also discusses the role of fuel suppliers, noting however, that these organisations are not DASA regulated entities.
