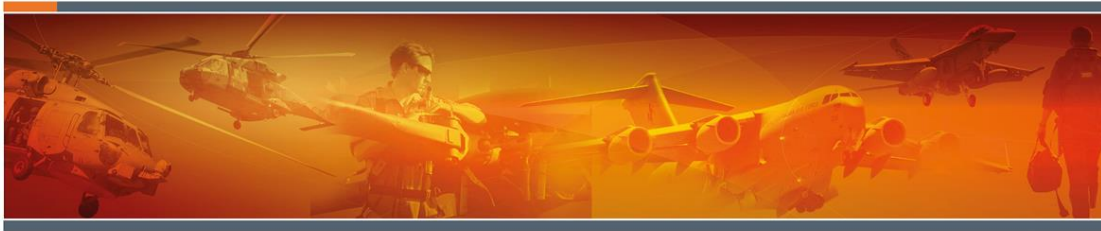

Course Duration

36 Weeks

Course Content

The aim of this course is to graduate personnel with the knowledge, skills and attitudes necessary to perform NDT duties, testing of aerospace structures, components and GSE as a Level 2 Technician.

This course provides theory and practical instruction to graduate the trainees as fully qualified and certified Level 2 NDI Technicians in the following methods:

- Liquid Penetrant Testing,
- Magnetic Testing,
- Eddy Current Testing,
- Ultrasonic Testing and,
- Radiographic Testing

Target Audience

Air Force LAC/Ws who are qualified technicians within the ATECH, AVTECH, ASTTECH and ARMTECH mustering, having successfully completed the Trade Supervisors Principles Course – Air (TSPC-A) (P101731), and passed the Trade Supervisor Selection Board (TSSB) (P010027), or recognised equivalent from the other Services or Civilian sector.

Training Nominations

NDI Technician Level 2 course nomination is via EOI from the DP-AF EOI webpage, EOI are promulgated on the DP-AF webpage each year.

Contractor nominations: It is Defence policy to charge Non-Government and Government organisations when Defence supplies goods or services in accordance with Australian Government Cost Recovery Guidelines (Resource Management Guide No. 302, 304) and Defence Finance Group guidance. The cost of the NDITECHL2 course is \$30 258.15, as such, civilian contractor nominations are to be forwarded and authorised through their relevant sponsoring System Project Office (SPO). Headquarters Air Force Training Group will only accept nominations from the SPO's nominated liaison officer. Authorisation from the sponsoring SPO regards Course Cost Recovery must be given prior to nomination.
