### INTRODUCTION

1. This document summarises noteworthy changes incorporated into the Defence Aviation Safety Regulation (DASR) in the 29 Apr 21 release. All changes incorporated in this release are minor or editorial in nature; i.e. they improve clarity and do not alter compliance requirements. Full details of all changes, including previous text and rationale for the change, are available at Reference A.
2. Reference B provides further detail regarding changes to the Flight Operations Implementing Regulations.

### NOTEWORTHY MINOR AND EDITORIAL CHANGES

#### General

3. **Glossary.** The glossary definition of Airworthiness Limitation was amended.
4. **Review of Australian content in DASR M and 145.** Some content unique to DASR ('green text') has been amended or deleted to improve clarity. Supporting information is available in References C through F.
5. **Aircraft Structural Integrity (ASI) and Propulsion System Integrity (PSI) Management.** Multiple changes to DASR 21, M and 145 Acceptable Means of Compliance (AMC) and Guidance Material (GM) to improve clarity of ASI/PSI management requirements. A change to the wording of 21.A.44(c) clarifies ongoing monitoring requirements for ASI/PSI management applicable to holders of type-certificates and restricted type-certificates.

#### *DASR 21 Aircraft Design, Production and Certification*

6. **AMC to 21.A.20.** Changes to wording to articulate the intended use of recognition in certification and to remove the notion that the NAA/MAA is responsible for making risk treatment decisions for Defence Applicants.

7. **ARO.100 Purpose Statement and Implementing Regulation Clarity.** Replication of non-discretionary AMC into Implementing Regulation (IR), see Reference B, and updates to the purpose statement in GM.

8. **Aircrew.10 IR Clarity.** Replication of non-discretionary AMC into IR, see Reference B.

9. **Purpose Statement Updates.** Updates to purpose statements in GM to Aircrew.10, GM to Aircrew.55 and GM to Aircrew.60.

10. **Purpose Statement Clarifications.** Updates to various purpose statements only.

**DASR SPA Specific Approvals**

11. **SPA.10 Purpose Statement Clarification.** Update to the purpose statement only.
